
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After taking the quiz over a group of words, students should add those words to the Short-Term Memory box and review them every day.

Each time they get a word right, they check a box in the Memory Box.




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2. Long-Term Memory

Once a card has 5 check marks, it moves to Long-Term Memory. Students should quiz themselves every three or four days. If the student gets a word right, it moves to the DONE! box. If not, it returns to Short-Term Memory.




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
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
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3. DONE!
